Dancing Raisins



Ever thought raisins could dance? With the help of some kitchen ingredients you'll be able to see them boogey!

Ingredients

- * Baking Soda
- * Raisins
- * Vinegar

Step 1

Fill a clear glass $\frac{3}{4}$ full of water.

Step 2

Add a tablespoon of baking soda. Give it a good stir. If the baking soda sits on the bottom of the glass, you will need to stir it until it has dissolved into the water.

Step 3

Pop a few raisins into the glass. They will sit on the bottom at this point, (if you are using a small glass, don't put too many raisins in).

Step 4

Add a tablespoon of vinegar to the mixture.
