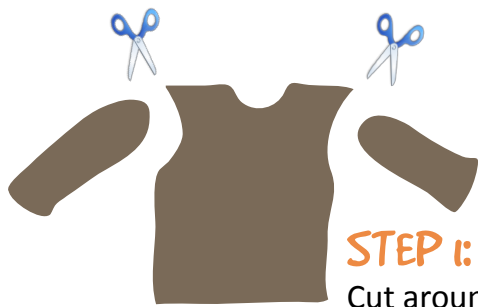




## Make a Viking costume



Make a Viking costume using an old coat. You will need an old fleece or fake fur coat. Dark colours are best.



**STEP 1:**  
Cut around sleeves at shoulder.



**STEP 2:**  
Cut zip out or if you are using an over-head fleece simply cut down the front to make a jacket.



**STEP 3:**  
Add a belt or use a piece of fabric for a belt.



**STEP 4:**  
Take the cut-off sleeves (from Step 1) and fit, shoulder side down, around the feet and ankles. Secure by wrapping string or strips of fabric around the ankles.



**STEP 5:**  
For a cape use a rectangular piece of fabric such as an old blanket and safety pin at each shoulder.



**STEP 6:**  
Glue wrapping foil or tin foil to a piece of card. Cut 2 circular discs out from the card and pin one to each shoulder of the cape.
